

Information for Parents and Students from Superintendent, Dr. Matt Akin:

We are continually monitoring information related to COVID-19. Additionally, we are receiving regular updates from the Alabama State Department of Education and the Alabama Department of Public Health. I understand that this is a worrisome and stressful time for your family, and I assure you that we will be here to support you. Below is information related to many school operations. School Closures

Per the Governor's mandate, all Gulf Shores City Schools will be closed on Thursday, March 19 through April 3. Spring break is still scheduled for April 6-10. While the school buildings will be closed, office personnel will be answering the phones, and administrators and teachers will be monitoring email. Currently, the central office will remain open.

Students are not required to attend school on Tuesday and Wednesday. We are remaining open through Wednesday because we understand that many parents are in the process of making childcare arrangements for the upcoming closure. The after-school programs will remain open through Wednesday afternoon.

If your child is not attending school this week, you may pick up digital devices and/or printed instructional materials at the school on Wednesday.

Learning Plan

During the state-mandated school closure, Gulf Shores City Schools is committed to providing learning opportunities for our students. To prevent an instructional gap, our teachers have prepared digital and printed learning materials. These materials can be accessed through your child's online Google Classroom or Canvas account. Students in grades 2-12 will be able to take their digital device home to access these instructional opportunities. Families who do not have access to the internet should contact the central office to check out a hotspot. Printed copies of learning materials are also available if needed. Students in preK-1 will be provided with written materials and books to take home.

During the school closure, teachers will be available during regular school hours to support you and your child through digital communication should you need assistance with these learning activities. Students who receive services through special education, the English Language



Learner program, and/or Section 504 should contact their case manager for questions or additional support.

While these learning activities are optional, we strongly encourage children to complete these activities if possible. Continuing the learning process during the school closure will help your child stay on track for grade-level success. We know that education is of utmost importance to your family, and we want to support our children during this unusual time.

Child Nutrition Program (Food Service)

Gulf Shores City Schools will implement a School Closure Feeding Program on these dates

We will be serving meals utilizing a drive-thru pick up at <u>Gulf Shores High School</u> between 11:00 am and 12:00 pm daily.

Free Meal Program Details:

- 1. Meals are FREE to all Gulf Shores students and anyone under age 18.
- 2. Food served is healthy and follows USDA nutrition guidelines.
- 3. No application or proof of income is needed to participate.

Medication

If your child has prescription medication that is a controlled substances and/or refrigerated medications stored in the nurse's office, they <u>must be picked up by a parent or guardian no later than March 18, 2020 at 3:00pm.</u> Any other prescription medications in the health room you feel may be needed at home during the school closure may also be picked up. These medications must be signed out on the Medication Administration Record (MAR).
